

How do I go about competing in a foreign FEI (international level) competition?

You must complete an Application for International Competition, pay a \$75.00 fee per competition and the High Performance fee of \$200 in addition to meeting the criteria.

What if I don't meet the criteria to compete in foreign FEI competitions?

You can request a waiver from the discipline credentials committee. Ask Athlete Services for the form explaining the step by step process to request a waiver.

How do I go about competing in a foreign national level competition?

You must fill out a National Permission Questionnaire and return it to Athlete Services where a permission letter to the Federation in the country in which you wish to compete will be prepared and sent. You will receive a copy of the letter for your records. We suggest that you carry this letter with you when you go to the competitions.

Do I need to go through Athlete Services to compete in Canadian competitions?

It depends, for any FEI level competition (i.e. CCI, CDI, etc.) competitors must enter through Athlete Services. Our Federation has reciprocity with the Canadian Equestrian Federation for US riders wishing to enter national level competitions in Canada therefore it's not necessary to contact Athletes Services when entering Canadian national level competitions.
