The Dressage Credentials Committee had a recent conference call to establish a guideline for waiver requests for unproven combinations. The Committee wishes to emphasize that there should be a natural and orderly progression involved in the path of working one's way up to competing in European CDIs. The Members have therefore decided that from this point forward, unproven combinations that apply for European CDIs and require a waiver must have competed as a combination in at least 2 CDNs in Europe with 2 or more judges officiating and have received scores averaging a minimum of 64%. These CDNs must have taken place within 6 months of the start date of the competition in question.
