### *Differences Between Judging a Dressage Test and a Young Horse Test*

#### **YOUNG HORSE TEST**

#### **DRESSAGE TEST**

Will the horse have a future as an FEI-level dressage horse?	→	A dressage test
The possibilities of the future are most important	→	What is shown NOW is most important
The athleticism, basic paces, uphill balance, and general impression are judged	→	The details and precision are judged
A little tension in the beginning will have nearly no influence on the final marks	→	A little tension is noted and will be marked accordingly whenever it occurs
The dressage movements MUST show a correct training path	→	The dressage movements must be correct from beginning to end
Important are the mistakes which have something to do with the training scale	→	The dressage movements must be correct from beginning to end
Minor mistakes should be judged with some lenience	→	Error in form and minor mistakes will be used to modify the score
The judging of the seat, aids and influence of the rider plays a secondary role.	→	The judging of the seat, aids and influence of the rider plays an important role
