### *Rules and Regulations*

The 2011 Collecting Gaits Farm/USEF Dressage Festival of Champions is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book and published Selection Procedures and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

### **USEF Membership Statement (GR901.9)**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

## **U.S. Equestrian Federation, Inc. Entry Agreement**

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable -casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. **The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**1. Entries are by invitation only.** For the Pony, Junior, Young Rider, and "Brentina Cup" divisions, the top twelve (12) horse/rider combinations in each division (according to USEF rankings) will be invited to participate in these Championships. For Grand Prix and Intermediaire I divisions only, if a rider qualifies more than one horse in the top fifteen (15) ranked rider/horse combinations, the next-ranked rider/horse combination will also be invited to attend, up to a maximum of fifteen (15) different RIDERS. However, each rider may only qualify a maximum of two (2) horses. Refer to complete published Selection Procedures for each division.

**2. Parking** on grounds will be restricted, in the interest of safety and security. Vans and trailers must be parked in designated areas with passes visible in windshields. All competitors must follow parking directions. General admission & parking is \$20/car per day.

**3. Camping** is not permitted on the grounds.

**4. Stabling:** All horses kept on the grounds must be in stabling provided. Stabling will be available on Monday, September 5th. Stalls in the main barn (for Intermediaire I horses only) are permanent 12'x12' and have doors. Temporary tent stabling 10'x10' (with stall doors) will be provided for the Grand Prix, Brentina Cup, Young Rider & Junior horses, and Ponies.

- a. Main Barn: \$250 per stall for Intermediaire I (Selection Trials) horses includes three (3) bags of initial bedding;
- b. Main Barn: \$350 per stall for non-Selection Trials horses ridden by the rider of a horse in the Selection Trials) includes three (3) bags of initial bedding;
- c. \*Tent Stabling: \$350 per stall includes three (3) bags of initial bedding;
- d. Main Barn Tack Stalls: \$100 per stall;
- e. Tent Tack Stalls: \$100 per competitor. Tent Tack Stalls **will be shared by two competitors.**

\* A limited number of double stalls are available in Tent Stabling for \$700 per stall. Grand Prix horses have priority for double stalls based on date of written request to secretary.

A \$150 per stall deposit is required in a separate check to be returned after stall is completely stripped and swept/raked clean and management declares that the stall has been left in satisfactory condition.

Due to limited stabling, additional (non-competing) horses cannot be accommodated.

**5. Security & Night Watch:** Overnight stabling security & night watch service is included in stabling fee. Overnight security service will begin Wednesday, September 7, 2011.

**6. Feed, Hay and Bedding:** Feed and hay are not available on the grounds, but may be ordered from Somerset Grain & Feed. All orders must be placed through the Show Office. **First delivery will be September 6, 2011. NO FEED DELIVERY BEFORE TUESDAY- BE SURE TO BRING ENOUGH FEED THROUGH TUESDAY. NO FEED DELIVERY ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY, ORDER ENOUGH FEED THROUGH WEEKEND** Orders for feed and hay must be received at the show office by 10:00am for delivery the same day. Please be prepared to pay by credit card (Visa or Mastercard) when placing a feed/hay order. Bedding (shavings bags) are available for purchase on the grounds for \$8 per bag. *Please note: Once purchased, bags of bedding may NOT be returned!*

**7. Arrivals:** All competitors must indicate arrival dates and times on their entry. The front gates to Hamilton Farm are **LOCKED** – if you are arriving prior to Tuesday September 6<sup>th</sup> and do not notify management well ahead of time regarding your arrival time so that someone can meet you, you will **NOT** be able to enter the facility and horses may be forced to remain on vans.

**8. Dogs** will not be permitted on the premises unless restrained on a leash. Stable dogs must be confined at all times. Any owner of a dog found loose on the Show Grounds during a competition will be fined \$100. Litigation fees resulting from any incident will be the responsibility of the dog owner. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.

9. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any classes; to alter advertised times or officials if necessary; or to refuse any entry. The Committee also reserves the right to use its discretion in matters not specified in the rules.

10. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make any such changes to the Prize List as conditions and its judgment dictate, subject only to giving appropriate notice to all participants.

11. Competitors are responsible for safeguarding their own cash and valuables, and are advised to leave valuables at home or locked in personal vehicles.

12. Competitors are expected to behave courteously toward show staff, USEF staff, USET Foundation staff, Hamilton Farm Golf Club staff, volunteers and fellow competitors, upon penalty of elimination from the competition.

13. **Awards:** Ribbons through 12<sup>th</sup> place for the Pony, Junior, Young Rider, and "Brentina Cup" classes (additional placings may be provided if necessary). Trophy and dress sheets to Champion and Reserve in each division. Ribbons through 15<sup>th</sup> place for the Intermediaire I and Grand Prix classes (additional placings may be provided if necessary). Trophy and dress sheets to Champion and Reserve in each division.

14. **Awards Ceremonies:** Awards will be scheduled immediately following each class or during the lunch break. Riders are to be FORMALLY ATTIRED AND MOUNTED for all award ceremonies. **Competitors who are not present for awards ceremonies will be eliminated.**

15. **Health Requirements:** The state of NJ Health Dept. requires a Negative Coggins within 12 months & Health Certificate within 30 days of the competition.

16. **Entries:** PLEASE READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY! ILLEGIBLE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES will be considered INVALID and returned. If the check or the Coggins Test is missing, the entry will be considered incomplete. Telephone entries are not permitted. Faxed entries must be followed by a hard copy in the mail. Completed entries are to be mailed to the **Show Secretary** and must be RECEIVED NO LATER THAN DATE(S) SPECIFIED or will be considered as Post Entries.

- a. Entries are by invitation only. **Opening date for the competition is when invitation is received.**
- b. **Secretary must receive ALL entry information by closing date of Tuesday, August 30, 2011.** If we do not hear from you by this date, your invitation will be forfeited and an alternate will be invited to attend in your place.
- c. All entries must be TYPED OR PRINTED ON THE USEF DRESSAGE FESTIVAL OF CHAMPIONS DRESSAGE ENTRY FORM and must include:
  - 1.) Three original signatures - owner(s), rider, trainer;
  - 2.) All information on BOTH SIDES of the entry form;
  - 3.) Photocopy of a negative Coggins Test dated within 12 months of competition;
  - 4.) Check or money order made **payable to the USEF** and cleared on a U.S. Bank;
  - 5.) Photocopies of USEF Membership Cards for riders, trainers, coaches and owner(s).

**17. Show Office Hours:** The Show Office will be open by 1:00pm to 5:00pm on Tuesday, September 6, 2011. During the event, the Show Office will be open one hour before the first class and close one hour after the last class of the day.

**18. Refunds:** Before closing date entries will be refunded in full, except for a \$25 office/entry processing fee. After the Closing Date there will be no refunds.

**19. Arenas:** One 20 x 60 meter competition arena with sand/fiber mixture footing. One large but not regulation size indoor arena with sand/fiber mixture footing. Two outdoor 20 x 60 warm-up arenas with sand/fiber mixture footing.

**20. Schooling:** Schooling schedule will be posted in the show office.

**21. Freestyle Music:** CD's must be CLEARLY LABELED with entry name, number and musical directives, **Intermediaire I and Grand Prix CD's must be delivered to the announcer's booth no later than 12:00 NOON on Friday, September 9<sup>th</sup>.** CD's must be picked up from the announcer after the class. Unclaimed CD's will NOT BE MAILED. **Sound check times will be posted in show office.** All sound checks are UNMOUNTED. Sound check order will be conducted in numerical order by bridle number.

**22. Veterinary Inspection:** Competitors in the 2011 USEF National Dressage Championships will have a mandatory veterinary inspection. FEI passports are required for Grand Prix and Intermediaire I horses, but are NOT required for Ponies, Brentina Cup, Young Rider, or Junior horses. Unsound horses will be eliminated. The decision of the Inspection Panel is Final.

\*Intermediaire I/Selection Trial: Wednesday, September 7, 2011 at 3:00pm

Grand Prix: Wednesday, September 7, 2011 immediately following Intermediaire I/Selection Trial

"Brentina" Cup: Wednesday, September 7, 2011 immediately following Grand Prix

Young Rider: Wednesday, September 7, 2011 immediately following "Brentina" Cup

Junior Rider: Wednesday, September 7, 2011 immediately following Young Rider

Pony Rider: Wednesday, September 7, 2011 immediately following Junior Rider

*\*Intermediaire I should refer to Pan American Games Selection Trial criteria for complete selection information.*

**22.** Food Service will be available during the show hours on the grounds.

**23. Entry fee:** There are no entry fees. However, the USEF Fee (includes Drugs and Medications fee), USEF non-member fees (if applicable), stabling and tack stall fees must be returned with entry form. All competitors MUST pay for horse stalls and tack stalls. Only tent stabling competitors may pay for ½ tack stall fees.

**24.** Whips are NOT ALLOWED for any class. Championship rules will be followed.

**25. Starting Order:** Starting order for all classes except the Grand Prix Special, Grand Prix Freestyle and Intermediaire I and Intermediaire I Freestyle will be determined by Open Draw, which for Thursday classes will take place immediately after the Veterinary Inspection on Wednesday. The draw for subsequent classes will take place after the awards ceremony on the previous day. Starting order for the GPS will be determined by draw in groups of 5 (or applicable number) conducted in reverse order of placing in the GP. Starting order for the GPF will be determined by draw in groups of 5 (or applicable number) conducted in reverse order of placing in the GPS. Starting order for the Intermediaire I will be determined by draw in groups of 5 (or applicable number) conducted in reverse order of placing in the Prix St. Georges. Starting order for the Intermediaire I Freestyle will be determined by draw in groups of 5 (or applicable number) conducted in reverse order of placing in the Intermediaire I.

**26. Rules:** Brentina Cup, Young Rider, Junior and Pony Championship classes will be conducted in accordance with USEF rules and with the 2011 USEF National Dressage Championships criteria for each division. Intermediaire I and Grand Prix Championships classes will be conducted under FEI rules and in accordance with the 2011 USEF National Dressage Championship criteria (for GP) and the 2011 USEF Dressage Selection Procedures for the 2011 Pan American Games (for Intermediaire I/PAG Selection classes).

**24.** Sharps containers are located in each barn. Management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

**NOTICE:** The Organizing Committee, the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. the United States Equestrian Team Foundation, Hamilton Farms Golf Club Inc., LLC., the officials, will not be responsible for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

***Attention Competitors:***

- Candidates and horse owners will be required to agree to abide by the USEF Code of Conduct and USEF Code of Ethics and Conflict of Interest Policy.
- Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USEF, USDF) for horse, owner(s), rider and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.
- All stabling will be secured and access will be given to those with a wrist band. Each competitor will be given five wrist bands (2 for rider, 1 for groom, 2 for owners).
- General Admission is free.
- General parking is \$20/car per day.
