



## ***2010 USEF YOUTH/PONY OUTREACH CLINICS***

In 2010, USEF will be hosting three clinics for youth on horses or ponies as a continuation of the pilot program started last year. International rider and trainer Lendon Gray will be conducting the clinics. In addition to instruction for riders, information sessions for parents will focus on how to guide and support children through FEI pony, junior and young rider competition. Also, the coach of each student is invited to be a part of the instructional sessions to receive suggestions on how to continue with the work in the rider's regular lessons. Each training session will have lessons focusing on seat and use of aids and private lessons. The two day sessions will also have practice test riding. Each rider will leave with a written evaluation and suggestions for improvement. There may be lectures at each session as well.

**Riders meeting the following criteria are welcome to apply. Riders with different credentials should outline them in detail in #5, with supporting documentation:**

Received at least two (2) scores at 62% or higher from two (2) different judges:

- Riders 13 and under on horse or pony at First Level and above;
- Riders 15 and under on horse or pony at Second Level and above;
- Riders 18 and under at Third Level and above.

To be considered for one of the USEF Youth/Pony Clinics, this application and all supporting documents must be completed in full and received by the USEF Dressage Department no later than **Friday, October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.**
