Standings for the Young Rider Team

The Young Rider (CH-N.AM-YR-S) standings will be based on money won in USEF Junior, Young Rider, Amateur Owner Jumper and Open Jumper classes held at 1.30m (4'3") or above, as well as Grand Prix classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money. The qualifying time period will be June 17, 2009 through June 15, 2010.

Standings for the Junior Team

The Junior (CH-N.AM-J-S) standings will be based on money won in USEF Junior, Young Rider, and Open Jumper classes held at 1.30m (4'3") or above, as well as Grand Prix classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money. The qualifying time period will be June 17, 2009 through June 15, 2010.

Ties

Any ties will be decided by determining which horse/rider combination won the most money in the classes specified above held at 1.40m or above.
