Standings for Teams

Standings will be based on points earned in Young Rider/Junior Jumper qualifying classes in Alaska (3'6" – 4'0"), and classes held at 1.35m or 4'6" and above at USEF recognized competitions. Each rider must complete at least one Young Rider/Junior Jumper qualifying class in Alaska, and complete at least three classes held at 1.35m or 4'6" and above at USEF competitions. Points will only be awarded for the three highest placing classes held at 1.35m or 4'6" and above for each rider. The qualifying time period will be June 18, 2010 – May 31, 2011. If a rider has competed at the NAJYRC, he/she may waive the Alaska qualifying class requirement to be eligible for the team the following year.

Horses

Riders are not required to compete in the Alaska Young Rider/Junior Jumper qualifying classes on the same horse that they will compete on at the Championships. A rider representing Zone 12 at the Championships must use the same horse the rider used in the qualifying classes held at 1.35m or 4'6" and above.

Ties

Any ties will be decided by determining which horse /rider combination won the most points from the three highest placing classes held at 1.35m or 4'6" and above.

Declaration fee:

The Zone 12 selection trial declaration fee is \$50 per horse/rider combination sent to the Zone Coordinator and is due on or before June 1, 2011.

Verification and Application

The application form and verification of placings/completion of required classes held at 1.35m or 4'6" and above must be received by the Zone 12 Coordinator no later than June 1, 2011 to be considered for the Zone 12 team for that year. The application forms include: Official Application (accompanied by a \$50 fee), and USEF Code of Conduct.

Point System

Placings in Alaska Young Rider/ Junior Jumper qualifying classes:

1 st Place	5 points
2 nd Place	3 points
3 rd Place	2 points
4 th Place	1 point
*Course Completion	½ point

Placings in classes held at 4'6" and above (USEF competitions)

1 st Place	30 points
2 nd Place	20 points
3 rd Place	15 points
4 th Place	10 points
*Course Completion	5 points

*Course Completion is defined as not being disqualified, eliminated, or withdrawn per USEF Rules.
