



REQUIREMENTS FOR ENROLLMENT

Combined Driving Course Designers

ENROLLMENT INTO TRAINING PROGRAM

1. Applicant must be at minimum of 21 years of age and must be a Senior Active member of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF).
2. Applicant must have competed at the Advanced level at four (4) USEF licensed Combined Driving competitions, or have instructed at least two drivers who meet this requirement, or have practical experience at the Advanced level.
3. Applicant must have designed courses at the Preliminary, Intermediate, or Advanced level. These courses must have been at two or more sites.
4. Applicant must receive a passing score of 85% or higher on the USEF Combined Driving Course Designers' written examination. The examination will be mailed to everyone who applies for enrollment into the training program.
5. The requirements may be reduced or waived by the Licensed Officials Committee upon the recommendation of the USEF Driving Committee.
6. An application for a license as a Recorded Combined Driving Course Designer will not be considered unless and until 15 evaluations are returned to the USEF Licensed Officials Committee from members of the Federation, at least eight (8) of which must come from the current list of USEF Combined Driving Judges, Technical Delegates, and Course Designers, and the remaining obtained from members of the USEF Driving Committee, Combined Driving organizers, or USEF members who are Combined Driving competitors. Staff automatically sends evaluations to those people listed by the applicant as well as every member of the USEF Combined Driving Committee. *NOTE: Do not include members of the Licensed Officials Committee or the relevant breed/discipline committee in your list of reference as they will automatically receive your evaluation. (Committee lists are available on the USEF website)*

REQUIREMENTS OF TRAINING PROGRAM

After receiving notification of acceptance into the training program, the applicant must:

1. Complete apprenticeship with two different USEF Course Designers at the Intermediate level or above.
2. Complete the Course Design Clinic section of the USEF or FEI Training Program.
3. Receive a minimum score of 85% on the closed-book written examination that will be given at the conclusion of each clinic.
