

KEEPING HORSES HEALTHY

FOUR STEPS TO CLEANING

1

REMOVE ORGANIC MATERIAL



Surface removal of any visible dirt, manure or other debris should be removed by wiping, brushing, scraping, sweeping, scooping or other methods.

2

WASH WITH DETERGENT

Washing the stall or equipment with soap or detergent and water will remove any remaining material adhered to the surfaces. A detergent (such as Dawn Powerwash, etc.) will assist in removing caked on materials.



4

ALLOW SURFACE TO DRY

The item or area should be allowed to dry completely before the disinfection process. Excess water can dilute the disinfection.



3

RINSE OFF DETERGENT

Soaps and detergents can inactivate some disinfectants so it is important to clean the surface of all detergents and soaps.
