# The History of the Saddle Seat Adult Amateur Medal Final

The American Horse Shows Association (AHSA) equitation medal was established in 1937 by the fourth President of the AHSA, Adrian Van Sinderen, as part of his strategy to connect horse people across the United States. In 2001, the tradition of the medal program was extended to the adult amateur exhibitor by offering the USEF Saddle Seat Adult Amateur Medal Final. The Final was created for adult amateur riders to continue to participate in the discipline of Equitation. Since its inception, the USEF Saddle Seat Adult Amateur Medal Final has been held during the Lexington Junior League Horse Show in Lexington, Kentucky.



# **Recognition & Awards**

The champion and trainer are presented with commemorative awards. Both the champion and reserve champion receives the traditional USEF medals and bouquets of roses along with coolers for their mounts. The third place rider is honored with the USEF bronze medal. Ribbons to tenth place are presented.

# **Eligibility**

Amateur riders age 18 and over are eligible to compete in the USEF Saddle Seat Adult Amateur Medal Final by having shown and been judged in an official qualifying class during the specified qualification period. Riders perform on the rail as a group and are required to complete an individual workout selected by the judges. If entries warrant the class may be run as two phases, a preliminary and a final. If run as one phase, judging is based on 50% rail work and 50% workout.
