## Rule Change Intent

GR901.9 was changed a few years ago to have exhibitors at the Modified Level need to be an active member of the Federation or submit a show pass. When the rule change went through the first part of GR901.9 was updated;however, the language in the actual membership statement still indicates the Preliminary Level instead of the Modified level. In order to prevent any misunderstandings the word Preliminary should be changed to Modified.

## **GR901 Requirements**

See GR1212 for procedures regarding submitting prize lists to the Federation office. The prize list of every Licensed Competition must contain the following:

9. The following statement must be published in BOLD TYPE for all Regular Competitions; **Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above**, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules).

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, **Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary** (should be MODIFIED) Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes
