The intent of the restriction that went into effect Dec 1st is for those that don't own the horse they are riding. Amateurs that can show unlimited amounts of horses they don't own, may be doing so for reasons that are more professional in nature. However, Amateurs who show their own horses are doing so for their own pleasure and accomplishments. The amount of Amateurs this new restriction affected was much more than we could have anticipated and competitions would have been seriously affected by the lack of entries from Amateurs who own multiple horses.

Committee Actions

JP118 Sections/Classes Restricted to Junior, Amateur or Young Riders

1. Amateur Jumper: A horse that is ridden by an Amateur. Classes are restricted to riders who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. See GR 1306 for Amateur Rules.

a. Amateurs may compete up to two horses, ***that they do not own***, per height section of Amateur Jumpers per competition. ***There is no limit on the number of horses that may be ridden by the owner or an amateur member of the owner's family.***
