## Rule Change Intent

When the upper cheek of a hanging snaffle (baucher) is measured correctly as indicated in the rule above, almost no baucher bit available on the market measures 5 cm or less. Most measure around 6 centimeters. Keeping the rule as currently written effectively eliminates the use of the baucher. The rule was intended to disallow only those baucher bits with a long upper cheek that creates for leverage and poll pressure.
