USEF JUMPER SCHOOLING RULES

12. There may never ~~only be more than two (2)~~ **one rails** on the back of an oxer, ~~with the lower rail equal in height to the lowest rail on the front of the oxer~~ **The back rail must be equal to or higher than the top rail on the front of the oxer.**
