GR302.1.h. License Modification. Any changes to the License agreement including location, dates, rating, level, or prize money, will require a license modification request and payment of a fee. Any modifications resulting in a conflict will result in the loss of Priority Date Holder status. Any modification not resulting in a conflict shall comply with the provisions set forth below in order to retain Priority Date Holder status. USEF may or may not approve the requested changes. Exceptions: Eventing competitions without mileage conflict requesting changes outlined in GR302.1h5 must follow the Eventing competition modification process outlined in GR302.2g; ***Combined Driving: any modification request(s) to an existing license must follow the Federation's Combined Driving Calendar Policies and Procedures.***

h. Competitions hosting Combined Driving Division(s) must follow the new application process as outlined in the Federation's Combined Driving Calendar Policies and Procedures.
