***3. Spurs. Spurs must be made of smooth metal. Rowel spurs with serrated edges are not permitted. Hammer spurs are allowed. Smooth metal or plastic "impulse" spurs with round hard plastic or metal knobs and "Dummy" spurs with no shank are allowed. The contact surface with the horse and all edges must be smooth and rounded. When mounted, athletes may wear only one spur on each boot.***
