This would apply to classes up to 1.40m. It would require those fences in the schooling area to be within 10cm of the fence height of the current class. This is one of the few schooling rules not in line with the FEI's and it would reduce potentially unsafe situations when there is such a difference from what is expected in the competition ring.

APPENDIX A

USEF JUMPER SCHOOLING RULES

..

- 5. When schooling for a Five, Six, or Seven Year Old class in progress, jumps in the schooling area may not exceed the height or width by more than 10cm of the jumps in the class.
- 6. For classes up to 1.40m in obstacle height, the obstacles in the practice arena may not exceed in height and width ten centimeters more than the actual maximum height and width of the obstacles of the class in progress. If the obstacle height of the class in progress is greater than 1.40 m, the obstacles in the practice arena may not exceed 1.65 m in height and 1.80 m in width.

10. Jumps in the schooling area may not exceed 1.60m (5'3") in height, 1.80m (5'11") in width.
