32. Welsh

- a. Federation Registered Hunter judges can *may* officiate in 'A' rated Welsh Pony Hunter classes and 'A', 'B', and 'C' rated Welsh Pleasure classes *without a Guest Card*. Federation Registered Hunter judges may *shall* officiate a maximum of two times in a lifetime for in "A" rated Welsh Pleasure classes.
- b. If a Guest Judge is not a Federation Hunter judge, the Guest Judges must have approved status from the be a Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America Approved Judge in order to officiate in any class in the Welsh Delivision classes at Federation licensed regular or local competitions and must apply for with a Genest Ceard.
