The United States Equestrian Federation (U.S. Equestrian) is seeking an individual to serve as the Chef d'Equipe for the 2027 FEI Vaulting World Championship for Juniors and Young Vaulters in Verolanuova, Italy on August 2-8, 2027.

The Role of the Chef d'Equipe at the Championships is as follows:

- Attend Chefs d'Equipe Meetings and be the liaison with the Technical Delegate / Ground Jury / OC.
- Work closely with the Team Leader and Team Veterinarian both during the Championship as well as in preparation for the Championship.
- Determine with athletes and their personal coaches the competition strategy for U.S. athletes.
- Support athletes both at the Championship, as well as in preparation for the Championship and help them in creating a cohesive team atmosphere.
- Be available from start to finish of the contract for team support and Championship preparations.
- Manage and oversee all athletes / grooms / support staff / personal coaches / owners / parents during the Championship.
- Ensure all accredited individuals follow FEI Rules.
- Assist with the delivery of Clean and Safe Sport (equine and human).
- Ensure there is always someone to accompany the horse or athlete when either is called for Medication Control.
- Act as the point of contact for the team should there be an incident to manage.
- Participate in conference calls related to the Championship as needed.

The successful applicant will be required to pass a Background Check and remain current with the USEF Safe Sport Training Requirements.
