Congratulations! One or more of your competitions have been approved to host the 2019 FEI World Breeding Championship for Young Horses in Dressage (five, six, and seven year olds) Qualifying Classes. The approved calendar for all regions can be found on the USEF website [HERE](#). Additionally, the 2019 CDI Calendar is posted on the website [HERE](#) for your information. The Selection Procedures are posted on the website [HERE](#). Please review the calendars and Qualifying Requirements carefully for your competitions.

It is the responsibility of the competition manager to ensure their date is correct on the Qualifying Calendar. This date must also match your USEF Competition License. Should you require a date change to your USEF Competition License, please contact dates@usef.org.

PRIZE LISTS AND QUALIFYING PERIODS: Qualifying Competitions must be acknowledged in the header of the prize list in the following manner (please note sponsor changes from previous years!). Please note that because your competition is also a USEF/NAYC Qualifying Competition, the other Championship titles are also included.

For approved Qualifying Competitions scheduled between January 1, 2019 and June 17, 2019:

“Official Qualifying Competition for the 2019 Adequan FEI North American Youth Championships presented by Gotham North; the 2019 Children Dressage National Championship; the 2019 USEF Pony Rider Dressage National Championship; 2019 USEF Junior and Young Rider Dressage National Championships; and the 2019 USEF Young Adult ‘Brentina Cup’ Dressage National Championship presented by *Dressage Today*. Official Qualifying Competition for the 2019 Markel/USEF Young and Developing Horse Dressage Championships. Official Qualifying Competition for the 2019 FEI World Breeding Championships for Young Horses in Dressage (Five, Six, and Seven Year Olds).”

For approved Qualifying Competitions scheduled between June 17, 2019 and June 23, 2019:

“Official Qualifying Competition for the 2019 Adequan FEI North American Youth Championships presented by Gotham North; the 2019 Children Dressage National Championship; the 2019 USEF Pony Rider Dressage National Championship; 2019 USEF Junior and Young Rider Dressage National Championships; and the 2019 USEF Young Adult ‘Brentina Cup’ Dressage National Championship presented by *Dressage Today*. Official Qualifying Competition for the 2019 Markel/USEF Young and Developing Horse Dressage Championships.”



JUDGE REQUIREMENTS & REQUIRED TESTS:

Judges: A panel of at least two (2) FEI or USEF 'S' judges must officiate all FEI Young Horse Tests for Five, Six, and Seven-Year-Olds (*All Judges must have USEF or FEI Young Horse Judging Designation*)

Required Tests:

Five-Year-Old	Six-Year-Old	Seven-Year-Old

<i>These tests must be held as individual classes which are specifically designated as USEF FEI WBC qualifying. "Test of Choice" classes will not count towards a qualifying score.</i>		
<i>*The FEI Five-Year-Old Final Test and FEI Six-Year-Old Final Test also serve as qualifiers for the USEF National Championships</i>		

Important Reminders:

- 1. Level of Competition:** Competitions approved as USEF qualifiers are considered LEVEL 3 competitions. A competition and all associated officials and staff must fully comply with the requirements of a Level 3 competition (and/or above). In addition, the correct qualifying classes must be offered. Please refer to the Required Classes and Judge Requirements on page two. The Level 3 show cannot be immediately preceded by a show of a lower level (i.e. it is not permitted to hold a Level 2 show on a Friday and then the qualifier on Saturday and Sunday).
- 2. Date/Location Changes:** Approved dates reflect current license agreements on file with USEF. Any date, location, manager, and/or secretary changes for a competition must immediately be noticed, in writing, to the USEF Dressage Department. Any change in date or venue for an approved competition may affect qualifying status. Date and location changes will not be made on the qualifying competitions calendar until the Dressage Committee or their designees has reviewed and approved the request.
- 3. Qualifying Classes:** Qualifying classes may only be offered once per qualifying competition. NONE of the "qualifying" tests may be offered as part of a Test of Choice class (unless noted above).
- 4. Licenses:** All competitions must retain current and correct USEF licenses and USDF recognition. Competitions held over the course of a weekend are considered one qualifying opportunity, even if they have separate license/recognition numbers.



5. **CDIs:** In addition to the designated USEF Qualifying Competitions, CDIs may also serve as qualifiers. An athlete/horse combination cannot earn a qualifying score in a national competition (CDN) if a CDI with the respective division category is also held at the event, i.e. CDI-YH.
6. **Proper Section Codes for Score Reporting:** In addition to USEF and USDF score reporting requirements, approved Qualifying competitions are **REQUIRED** to e-mail these results VIA PDF to *both* the USEF & USDF Dressage Departments (iroberts@usef.org / results@usdf.org) within forty-eight (48) hours of the conclusion of your competition. Please be reminded that qualifying competitions held the final weekend of the 2019 NAYC qualifying period (June 23, 2019) must submit scores within twenty-four (24) hours of the competition's conclusion.

As a reminder, please use the section codes below when reporting scores to USEF Competitions Department via .DAT files. Additionally, we will be using Ryegate Show Service, Inc. to calculate the 2019 ranking lists. To do this we ask that you also send your .DAT files to annettel@ryegate.com.

If you determine that your competition is unable or unwilling to comply with these requirements and would like to be removed from the official qualifying competition list, contact me immediately.
