Application Instructions

The 2026 FEI World Championship U.S. Dressage Team Application is only available online at www.usef.org. You will need to log into your "My USEF" account. Be sure to have your USEF Membership ID and password available. Once you are logged in, you will need select the 'Athlete Dashboard' button and then select 'Online Applications.' From there, you will select '2026' as the year and then when the available applications appear, click 'Apply' for the FEI World Championship application. Application Deadlines & Fees

Please read the application paragraph in the <u>Selection Procedure</u> (Page 1) very carefully and note that deadlines will be adhered to with no exceptions.

Monday, March 2, 2026 at 11:59 PM Eastern	Application Deadline and Fee	\$75
Monday, March 9, 2026 at 11:59 PM Eastern	Late Application Deadline and Fee	\$300

March 9, 2026 at 11:59 PM Eastern is the last date an application can be accepted.

Application Confirmation

Upon receipt of your application and fee, you and your horse owner(s) will receive an email confirming the date your application and payment was received. If you do not receive an acknowledgement of your application, IT IS YOUR OBLIGATION to contact USEF to determine if it has been received.

2026 USEF Grand Prix National Championship

Athlete/horse combinations which have successfully completed the 2026 FEI Dressage World Championship application (including receiving an email confirming the date your application and payment was received) are not required to submit an additional application for the 2026 USEF Grand Prix National Championship (May 13-17, 2026, at the World Equestrian Center in Ocala, FL).

Clean Sport

Please remember athletes must adhere to all WADA, FEI, USOPC, and USADA anti-doping protocols, policies and procedures, and may be drug tested. Please contact Christy Hawkins with any questions at (859) 225-3045.

All horses that are registered with the FEI or USEF shall be subject to in-competition testing. FEI's philosophy is that horses must be "clean" at the time of competition. If seeking advice from a veterinarian ensure he/she is a registered FEI veterinarian and is fully conversant with the FEI Veterinary Rules the Prohibited Substance List.
