



2019 Zone 10 NAYC - Junior & Young Rider *Proposed Selection Method*

USHJA and the Zone 10 Committee have proposed the following Selection Methodology for Junior and Young Rider Teams for the 2019 North American Youth Championship. This Selection Methodology was approved by the Jumping Sport Committee as well as an Ad Hoc of the USEF BOD.

- **USEF Standings:** Two athlete/horse combinations and the Traveling Reserve Athlete/Horse combinations will be selected from the USEF Standings based on money won starting **October 1, 2018:**

The USEF Standings for each category (Junior and Young Rider) will be calculated as follows starting October 1, 2018:

Junior Standings: The USEF Junior (CH-N.AM-J-S) Standings will be based on money won in the following classes held at 1.40m and above at USEF licensed competitions: Junior Jumper, Young Rider, U25, Open Jumper, as well as Jumper classes offering at least \$25,000 held at Regional Standard or above. Classes offering more than \$25,000 will be capped at 25,000 points, thus pointed the same as classes of \$25,000.

Young Rider Standings: The Young Rider (CH-N.AM-YR-S) standings will be based on money won in the following classes held at 1.40m and above at USEF licensed competitions: Junior Jumper, Young Rider, Amateur Owner, Amateur Jumper, Open Jumper, U25, as well as Jumper classes offering at least \$25,000 held at Regional Standard or above. Classes offering more than \$25,000 will be capped at 25,000 points, thus pointed the same as classes of \$25,000.

- **Zone 10 Selection Trials:** Two athlete/horse combinations will be selected based on points earned at the Zone 10 Selection Trials. There will be four (4) Selection Trials with a total of five (5) Selection Trial classes. An athlete/horse combination's best three (3) out of a possible five (5) total classes will count for an athlete/horse combination's points in the Selection Trials. The following competitions will offer both a Junior Selection Trial and a Young Rider Selection Trial:
 1. Desert Circuit VIII – March 12-17, 2019, HITS Desert Horse Park in Thermal, CA
 2. Blenheim Spring Classic II – March 27-31, 2019, Rancho Mission Viejo Riding Park in San Juan Capistrano, CA
 3. Del Mar National Horse Show – April 30-May 5, 2019, Del Mar Fairgrounds in Del Mar, CA
 4. SHP Spring Classic – May 8-12, 2019, Sonoma Horse Park in Petaluma, CA
