Through supplemental, need-based funding, we support athletes selected to compete in US Equestrian high performance teams, competitions, and programs.

Whether traveling to elite international championships or gaining valuable experience through key development tours, the expenses of competing at the highest level—travel, horse transport, training, coaching—can be substantial.

This program bridges that gap, empowering athletes to focus on their performance and their dream of representing the USA.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Active U.S. Equestrian (USEF) member in good standing
- U.S. citizen
- Selected for US Equestrian high performance team or program
- Demonstrated financial need with supporting documentation

#### Age Groups (FEI Classification):

- Children (CH): 12 14 years
- Pre-Junior (PJ): 14 16 years
- Juniors (J): 14 18 years
- Young Riders (YR): 16 21 years
- U25: 16 25 years



Athletes who meet the criteria and need financial support may apply for funding to offset participation costs.

- Proof of Selection Include confirmation of invitation or selection.
- Financial Need Provide supporting documentation.
- Estimated Costs Detail anticipated expenses (travel, horse transport, training, coaching, etc.).
- Commitment Show dedication to high-performance sport.

Riders may submit applications to <u>uset.</u>
org/performance-pathway-grant-program
on a rolling basis for select USEF jumping
programs in advance of official team selection
or program invitation. Through this process,
applicants can receive pre-approval for a grant
based on their demonstrated financial needs.
Pre-approval allows applicants to plan ahead
for potential participation on a team and/or in
a high performance program. If selected to the
team or for the program, the funding request
will be finalized and confirmed.



### **SELECTION PROCESS**

Applications are reviewed by the USET Foundation Performance Pathway Grant Committee, comprising:

- US Equestrian sport leaders
- USET Foundation Trustees

Applicants for the Performance Pathway Jumping Grant Program will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Verified selection or invitation to a U.S.
   Jumping Team or recognized program
- Demonstrated financial need substantiated through the application
- Documented costs associated with participation in the designated competition or program
- Strong work ethic, commitment, competitive record, and drive to xcel in equestrian sport
