Application Deadline and Fees: Deadlines are enforced without exception. Upon receipt of your application and fee, you and your horse owner(s) will receive a confirmation email with the date your application was received, and horse(s) included on the application. If you do not receive a confirmation email regarding your application, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to contact Christina Vaughn (cvaughn@usef.org) to determine if it has been received.

Athletes wishing to be considered for the U.S. Eventing Team must complete an online application with the application fee through their [USEF Athlete Dashboard](#). Applications will be charged seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per application at the time of submission. **No applications will be accepted after April 17, 2026, at 11:59 PM EST.**

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the owner(s) of the horses they apply with have read and understand the Selection Process and Procedures, which can be found on the US Equestrian website [here](#).
