Recovering from Laminitis: A Success Story



"On March 18, 2019 - I got to the barn before sunrise like I did every morning, and this time I was looking forward to celebrating What a Trippi's 16th birthday with some special treats and a ride. The second I opened his stall door to throw him some hay, I knew something was wrong. He was standing just off enough to raise an alarm. I took him out of his stall and it was evident immediately that taking those few steps was very painful. My heart sank. I ran my hands down his legs and by the time I got to his feet, I knew what was going on. The heat was evident immediately. I called my veterinarian and he came right over. After some diagnostics, we were looking at one of a horse person's worst fears — laminitis."
