Re: CDIO-U25 Wellington, FL – March 17-21, 2021

The USEF anticipates receiving an invitation from the Organizer of the Global Dressage Festival to enter at least one team in the Wellington CDIO-U25 (March 17-21, 2021). Per FEI Rules, teams may consist of two or three athlete/horse combinations. The format will be published in the approved FEI Definite Schedule for the event.

Athletes interested in competing in this event must return a written declaration by February 28, 2021 in order to be considered for selection. Declarations must be submitted by email to lroberts@usef.org.

Athlete/Horse combinations must have earned at least one (1) score of 64% or higher in the FEI Intermediaire II Test since 1 January 2020 in either a CDI-U25 or the 2020 USEF Young Adult 'Brentina Cup' National Championships. If the number of declarations received exceeds the number of invitations received, the US Equestrian Dressage Sport Committee (or its designees) will consider the following when approving the entries:

1. All recent scores in the FEI Grand Prix 16-25 Test, FEI Intermediaire II Test and FEI Grand Prix Freestyle Test. FEI Grand Prix and FEI Grand Prix Special scores may also be considered.
2. Trend in scores.
3. Results from CDIs will carry a greater weight than results from CDNs, including National Championships.
