

Dressage TD Measurement Exam Policy

Dressage Technical Delegates (DTDs) have a total of three attempts to pass a practical measurement exam. If a DTD fails the practical measurement exam, the DTD may take the exam one additional time during their recertifying year. If a DTD fails the two attempts during their recertifying year, they are not able to renew their DTD license and they may complete a third attempt in the next competition year to reinstate their status.

- The DTD may test with the same measurement field examiner but must wait a period of 30 days between each attempt.
- The DTD must pay the fee to measure for all attempts.
- If the DTD does not pass in their recertifying year (fails two attempts), then they will not be able to renew their DTD license for the next competition year.

Maintenance requirements for Dressage TD License are outlined in the USEF Licensed Officials Policies and Procedures.
