CVI Grants for 2020 (Approved by the VSC 01/09/20)

The VSC will award grants for Junior and Senior vaulters to compete in CVI's in 2020.

Qualification:

Individual vaulters, squads and PDD who meet minimum scores criteria will be eligible for these grants. The minimum scores are aligned with the Pathways Developing and Elite criteria found on the USEF website. These are:

The vaulters' classification (developing, elite) will be based on the vaulters' scores 8 weeks before the start of the competition.

• If a vaulter's classification changes (ie development to elite) after the time they apply but before the application deadline (8 weeks), the grant amount will be readjusted.

The committee <u>will also consider</u> grant applications from vaulters who have earned only one or zero Pathways score, as well. Applicants with one or zero qualifying scores will be considered individually.

Applicable Events:

Grants can be used for any foreign or domestic CVI more than 500 miles from the vaulter's registered club.

Grant Amounts:

The VSC has a fixed budget for grants for 2020. Grants will be reviewed and awarded in order of receipt until the grant funds have been spent.

For both Juniors and Seniors, grants will be awarded as follows:

Additionally, vaulters who earn an elite score at the CVI will be awarded an additional \$500 per CVI. (Vaulters must request this bonus by submitting their scores to Laureen within 30 days of the competition date.)

Application:

The application will be posted on the USEF website and also announced by email (USEF vaulting membership) and Blast.

DRAFT Application

The vaulter will need to submit their own qualifying scores.

Application Deadline:

Applications are due 8 weeks before the start of the competition. No late applications will be accepted.

Vaulters are encouraged to submit grant application as soon as possible. Applications will be reviewed and awarded in order that they are received.

Other Criteria:

Vaulters may only be funded for two events per competition. If the vaulter is on a squad, the funding will be for the squad plus one additional event.

Applicants that meet the stated criteria for developing and elite will be approved on a rolling basis by the Grants Subcommittee. Applicants with zero or one Pathways scores will be considered individually by the Vaulting Sports Committee at their next scheduled meeting.
