2019 FEI World Reining Championships for Junior and Young Riders

-Qualification Period:

- January 1, 2018 - TBD 2019

-FEI Qualification Criteria: To be posted as soon as made available.

Riders are considered Juniors from the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 14 until the end of the year in which they turn 18.

Riders are considered Young Riders from the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the year in which they turn 21.

Horses must be 7 years of age or older to compete in FEI reining competitions.
