



US Equestrian Driving Oversubscription Procedures for FEI (H2) Horse Pair classes in 2019

The following procedure will be used to rank US Athlete/Horse combinations wishing to compete internationally in FEI CAI – H2 classes (Horse Pair). These rankings will determine selection for oversubscribed events outside of the United States.

Application

Athlete/horse combinations wishing to be considered for selection to CAIs outside of the United States must submit an FEI entry application for each event via the My USEF portal. The Opening & Closing date for Applications will be published on the USEF website and communicated.

Athletes must be in good standing with the USEF and FEI at time of Application and have completed all FEI and USEF required registrations and trainings.

Selection

The 2019 US Equestrian Driving Selection Committee will oversee the ranking at time of selection, unless the US Equestrian Board of Directors or an Ad hoc of the Board approves another group or method. For these purposes, “athlete/horse combination” is defined as the same combination of horses until 50% or more of the horses are changed within the combination.

Athlete/horse combinations will be ranked at least 7 days prior to each Event’s Definite entry date. Ranking will be based on the following objective and subjective considerations:

- 1) The athlete/horse combination’s trend of overall results;
- 2) The athlete/horse combination’s results in a specific competition phase, such as Dressage, Marathon, or Cones;
- 3) The number of competitions that the athlete/horse combination has entered in the previous 12 months at the CAI 2* level and above.

Note: These rankings have NO bearing on selection for the 2019 FEI World Driving Championships for Pairs.
