

USEF Lite Licensed Officials Search Tool

USEF Lite licensed competitions must have a Steward or Technical Delegate (TD) hired for the competition. This position must be filled to ensure someone who has no other duties at the competition, is on the grounds and is trained to handle emergency situations.

The competition can choose to hire any type of Steward or Technical Delegate, and they can be licensed or an applicant in the process of becoming licensed. If an applicant is hired, they must have the below steps completed.

- Applicant Stewards or TDs must be USEF Senior Active (Competing) members and must successfully complete SafeSport Training and LO Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion training.
- Applicant Stewards must successfully complete a background check (at their own expense).
- Applicant Stewards must successfully complete the five training modules and quizzes (which are all free of charge).

The USEF Licensed Officials Search can be found at the link below. This link allows you to search for Licensed Officials using numerous filters such as license type, state of residence, etc. There is a box to check if you are specifically searching for eligible Steward/TD applicants to hire.
