In principle, the program is open to six (6) U.S. citizens, ages 16 to 21, who are currently successful in competition at 1.40m or above.

Athletes are invited to participate in the 2026 Horsemastership Training Series based on their results at U.S. Jumping Pathway Programs, along with wild card athletes. Athletes from the pathway programs include Individual gold medalists of the FEI North American Junior and Young Rider Championships, Platinum Performance/USEF Talent Search Finals East/West, and the Turnham Green/USEF Junior Jumper National Championships.

Athletes wishing to participate in the Training Series must have completed a minimum of three (3) courses held at 1.40m or higher with a score of zero (0) faults within six (6) months of the close of application for the event. Athletes are required to bring a horse for use in the Training Series. Horses must be very fit and proficient at 1.40m or higher and over an open water.
