

2026 NAYC Water Certificate of Capability

FEI North American Youth Championships Junior and Young Rider Zones 1-9 July 28 – August 2, 2026

Athlete/horse combinations wishing to compete in the 2026 NAYC must have earned two (2) Certificates of Capability as described below, at USEF or FEI licensed competitions between **September 1, 2025 and June 8, 2026**. *Please note that the height Certificate of Capability has been automated and does not require a paper form*. The two requirements (height and water) may be met either in the same or different courses.

- 1. North American Young Rider Championships: https://athletes.usef.org/sport-apps/search
 - a. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course set at 1.45m or higher with a score of four (4) faults or less.
 - b. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course with either a 3 meter open water jump with or without a rail. In either case, the jump must be in accordance with USEF JP129.
- 2. North American Junior Championships:
 - a. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course set at 1.40m or higher with a score of four (4) faults or less.
 - b. Each athlete/horse combination must earn a Certificate of Capability by completing a course with either a 3 meter open water jump with or without a rail. In either case, the jump must be in accordance with USEF JP129.
