QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Published on 18/12/2018

1. Qualification period

Start:	1 January 2018
End:	Nominated entries: 2 September 2019
Second Nominated Entries for additional Individuals as per art. 927:	9 September 2019

2. Qualification criteria

To be applied in conjunction with Art. 913 and 914.1-6 of the FEI Driving Rules.

Drivers

Open to athletes who meet the following criteria and obtained the 3* status.

The Athlete must obtain the 3* Status as per art. 913.2, prior to obtaining the following qualifying results:

3* Drivers must achieve a score of 65 points or less in the Dressage test¹ and have successfully completed (without Elimination, Disqualification or Retirement) all three competitions (Dressage, Cones, Marathon) in their own class, at two (2) different International combined driving events.

One of the qualifying result as defined above must be achieved no earlier than on the 1^{st} January of the year in which the Championships take place and no later than the end date of the qualification period.

Maximum Driven penalty points allowed at the Championships in Dressage as per Art 914.4: 70 points

The following Dressage tests will be run at the Championships:

Pony Four in Hand: Dressage test 3*B HP4
Pony Pairs: Dressage test 3*B HP2
Pony Singles: Dressage test 3*B HP1

¹ Pony Four-in-Hand: dressage tests 3*D P4 or 3*B HP4

¹ Pony Pairs: dressage test 3*C HP2 or 3*B HP2

¹ Pony Singles: dressage tests 3*C HP1 or 3*B HP1



Article 906 Team Classification for Pony Championships

1. The Team classification will be determined by adding the score from the best Athlete in the Single Pony class, the Pair Pony class and the Four-in-Hand Pony class with the lowest penalties in each Competition. Only those scores of the team Members who have completed all three Competitions without Elimination can be counted towards the final Team scores.

Article 923 Entries World Pony Driving Championships

- 1. A national team shall consist of one or two Singles, one or two Pairs and one or two Four-in-Hands. Each nation is entitled to send up to a maximum of six Athletes.
- 2. NFs which cannot send a team may send up to two Athletes in each Class.
- 3. A spare Pony may be entered for the single Class. The Athlete who uses the spare Pony will be eligible for the individual classification as well as for the team classification. The spare Pony can only be substituted once not later than one hour before the start of Dressage and must be notified in writing to the Organiser.
- 4. Each NF is entitled to send a chef d'equipe and Veterinarian, both of whom will be accorded the same privileges as the Athletes.

Number of Entries

Number of foreign individual drivers:	2 per class (single, pair, four-in-hand) for those nations who have entered a national team.*
Number of home individual drivers:	4 per class (single, pair, four-in-hand)*-
