# Venue Updates

The Tryon International Equestrian Center is currently under going major building and construction in preparation of the 2018 WEG.

The venue will provide world class facilities that will offer permanent stabling, on-site housing, restaurants, and VIP hospitality.

The aim of the Organizing Committee is to build four onsite hotels for Athletes, Grooms, Team Veterinarians, Chefs de Mission and Chefs d'Equipe. At this point, it is unlikely that there will be additional on-site accommodations for individuals other than those listed.

## Accommodation

Athletes, Grooms, Chef de Mission, Chefs d'Equipe and Team Veterinarians will be housed on-site at the venue per the Organizing Committee. Team Staff, Horse Owners, personal trainers and support staff will be accommodated off-site and the USEF is securing a range of options. Additional limited accommodations will be available on a discipline specific basis for Owners of Selected horses as well as personal trainers. USEF is working in partnership with the USET Foundation on accommodation, hospitality and transport packages and rooms have been secured on the Biltmore Estate in Ashville. Those that are intending to attend WEG irrespective of Selection are encouraged to book packages with the Foundation.

### Accreditation

Accreditation will be in line as previous WEGs (Lexington and Normandy). Two horse owner accreditations per horse (4 per Driving Team) as well as one athlete partner accreditation (less Vaulting). Team Staff accreditations and additional accreditations for purchase will be prioritized on a performance basis. The U.S. Team will be under the same accreditation restrictions as other Nations.

### Tickets

Tickets will be purchased centrally and allocation will be decided on a discipline specific basis. Some Hospitality packages will also be secured by US Equestrian. Additional information will be forwarded once it becomes available.

## Transportation

The three airports near the Tryon International Equestrian Center are as follows:

- Asheville Regional Airport (AVL) 30 minutes
- Greenville-Spartanburg Airport (GSP) 45 minutes
- Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT) 1 1/4 hours

There will be airport transfers provided by the Organizing Committee for athletes. Transportation options will be available for those booking through the Foundation/Federation Partnership and additional information will be forwarded. The Organizing Committee will not be providing transport from the hotels to the venue.

Parking will not be on-site. A park and ride will be available.
