



Youth Jumping Competition – Aachen (GER) Ranking List Guidelines

January 9, 2026

The Youth Jumping Competition Ranking List is a list of athletes in ranked order by money won. This Ranking List includes athletes FEI aged 16-21. For the 2026 calendar year, this includes athletes born on or between 1 January 2005 and 31 December 2010.

Only classes held at USEF Licensed competitions and FEI competitions will be included. The list includes each eligible class but only the money won from the two highest money earning classes per competition will count towards the ranking.

Eligible classes include classes held at 1.45m and above: Junior Jumper, Amateur Jumper, U25, Open Jumper, as well as classes offering \$25,000 or more in prize money held at the National Standard and above.

Money won is 'aged out' over the calendar year meaning that the money won loses its value overtime. Money won ages out according to the following percentages:

Weeks 1-8: 100%	Weeks 33-36: 40%
Weeks 9-12: 95%	Weeks 37-40: 30%
Weeks 13-16: 90%	Weeks 41-44: 20%
Weeks 17-20: 80%	Weeks 45-48: 10%
Weeks 21-24: 70%	Weeks 49-52: 5%
Weeks 25-28: 60%	Weeks 53/+ : 0
Weeks 29-32: 50%	

The List is published weekly and includes results through three weeks prior. It's the athlete's responsibility to check results for accuracy. The List is subject to modifications and refinements by USEF from time to time.
