TED STEVENS OLYMPIC AND AMATEUR SPORTS ACT

- ► USEF is governed by the Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act in all areas 'central to governance'
 - ► The licensing of officials is considered an area 'central to governance'

US EQUESTRIAN'S ROLE

- Who makes the decision that someone can be a USEF Official?
 - USEF, with input from USEF's Licensed Officials Committee (LOC)
 - But first....
 - If applicable, the list of applicants meeting all requirements is sent to
 - Members of the respective USEF Committee and
 - ► The respective affiliate
- Who is on the LOC?
 - 12 people appointed by the President
 - Representatives from many breeds/disciplines are included



US EQUESTRIAN'S ROLE

- How often does the LOC meet?
 - ► The LOC meets multiple times throughout the year to review applicants for USEF licenses
 - ► The Committee reviews each application at length.
 - ► The LOC also meets several times a year by conference call to review other business.



- ► As a USEF licensed official, you agree to this Code of Ethics and Social Media Policy each time you renew your license(s).
- ► The LOC reviews the Code of Ethics annually.



LICENSED OFFICIAL CODE OF ETHICS

- As a licensed official of the United States Equestrian Federation, I will conduct my duties with the highest level of integrity. My primary concern is the welfare of the horse while giving full attention to exhibitors and respect to my colleagues.
 - ► I will endeavor to have complete and accurate knowledge of all rules governing the competition.
 - ► I will exercise my responsibilities in a positive and professional manner, refraining from conducting business and socializing with exhibitors during the event.
 - I will officiate from a positive perspective in word and deed and complete my duties with consistency and without bias.
 - My personal behavior will reflect my integrity, character and respect for the sport and the United States Equestrian Federation.
 - ► I will exude a professional and respectful attitude and behavior at all times toward USEF Staff, other licensed officials, and competition staff.
 - I will abide by the US Equestrian Social Media Policy for Licensed Officials.







Rule Changes

Proposed Rule Changes

The deadlines to submit proposed rule changes to be considered by the Board of Directors at their 2020 summer meeting are:

- September 6, 2019 for members;
- September 6, 2019 for committees and affiliates for proposed rule changes to the General Rules; and
- March 1, 2020 for committees and affiliates for proposed rule changes to the Breed and Discipline rules.

The September 1 deadline for members, committees, and affiliates has been extended to September 6, 2019 as the USEF office will be closed and all USEF resources will be unavailable August 30 to September 3 while we move to our new building.


