

INTERMEDIAIRE I

Prix St. Georges and Intermediate I Tests

1. All combinations participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last ride.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbon.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order (6th – 1st).
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. Return to the barn.

Intermediate I Freestyle and Overall Awards

1. All combinations participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last Freestyle ride.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbons and sashes.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order:
(6th - Champion).
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. 6th – 4th place return to the barn.
7. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall immediately dismount following your victory lap. You **MUST** have someone present to take your horse following your victory lap. Horses return to the barn.
8. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted into the arena (unmounted) for award presentations. No horses!
9. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted to the media tent for your press conference and to pick up trophies.

To keep the conditions safe for everyone, combinations cannot be led around the ring for the victory lap.

PARA DRESSAGE

Grand Prix A or Intermediate A Tests

1. All athletes participate in awards unmounted. No horses!
2. Meet at the dressage steward's tent immediately following the last Para Dressage ride.
3. Starting with Intermediaire I, athletes will be escorted into the arena in reverse order (6th – 1st) for awards and pictures.
4. Following the conclusion of the Intermediaire I awards, the Grand Prix athletes will be escorted into the arena in reverse order (6th – 1st) for awards and pictures.

Grand Prix B or Intermediate B Tests

1. All athletes participate in awards unmounted. No horses!
2. Meet at the dressage steward's tent immediately following the last Para Dressage ride.
3. Starting with Intermediaire I, athletes will be escorted into the arena in reverse order (6th – 1st) for awards and pictures.
4. Following the conclusion of the Intermediaire I awards, the Grand Prix athletes will be escorted into the arena in reverse order (6th – 1st) for awards and pictures.

Freestyle and Overall Awards

1. Meet in the Warm-Up. All athletes participate in awards unmounted following the last Para Dressage freestyle ride.
2. Champion and Reserve Champion horses will be dressed for awards and MUST have a handler.
3. Athletes and horses will be escorted into the arena for awards and pictures.
4. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted to the media tent for your press conference and to pick up trophies.

BRENTINA CUP

Intermediate II and Grand Prix 16-25 Tests

1. Top 6 participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up immediately following the last ride of the Inter. II or GP 16-25 tests.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbon.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order (6th – 1st).
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. Return to the barn.

Grand Prix Freestyle and Overall Awards

1. All combinations participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last Freestyle ride.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbons and sashes.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order in 2 groups:
Group 1: 12th – 7th
Group 2: 6th - Champion
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. 12th – 4th place return to the barn.
7. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall immediately dismount following your victory lap. You **MUST** have someone present to take your horse following your victory lap. Horses return to the barn.
8. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted into the arena (unmounted) for award presentations. No horses!
9. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted to the media tent for your press conference and to pick up trophies.

DEVELOPING HORSE

Prix St. Georges or Intermediate II Tests

1. Top 6 participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last ride.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbon.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order (6th – 1st).
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. Return to the barn.

Developing Horse GP or PSG and Overall Awards

1. All combinations participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last ride of your respective Developing Horse GP or PSG test.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbons and sashes.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order in 2 groups:
Group 1: 15th – 7th
Group 2: 6th - Champion
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. 15th – 4th place return to the barn.
7. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall immediately dismount following your victory lap. You **MUST** have someone present to take your horse following your victory lap. Horses return to the barn.
8. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted into the arena (unmounted) for award presentations. No horses!
9. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted to the media tent for your press conference and to pick up trophies.

Day 1 - 4 YO or 5, 6, and 7 YO Preliminary Tests

1. Top 6 participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last ride of your respective Young Horse test.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbons.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order (6th – 1st).
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. Return to the barn.

Day 2 - 4 YO or 5, 6, and 7 YO Final Awards and Overall Awards

1. All combinations participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last ride of your respective Young Horse test.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbons and sashes.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order in 2 groups:
Group 1: 15th – 7th
Group 2: 6th - Champion
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. 15th – 4th place return to the barn.
7. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall immediately dismount following your victory lap. You **MUST** have someone present to take your horse following your victory lap. Horses return to the barn.

3. Horses will be pinned with ribbons.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order in 2 groups:
Group 1: 12th – 7th
Group 2: 6th – 1st.
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. Return to the barn.

Day 2 – Individual Test Awards and Overall Awards

1. All combinations participate in awards.
2. Meet in the Warm-Up following immediately following the last ride of your respective Individual test.
3. Horses will be pinned with ribbons and sashes.
4. Combinations will be escorted to arena in reverse order in 2 groups:
Group 1: 12th – 7th
Group 2: 6th - Champion.
5. A staff member will direct athlete when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
6. Once around the arena and exit. 12th – 4th place return to the barn.
7. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall immediately dismount following your victory lap. You **MUST** have someone present to take your horse following your victory lap. Horses return to the barn.
8. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted into the arena (unmounted) for awards presentation. No horses!
9. Champion, Reserve Champion, & Third Overall will be escorted to the media tent for your press conference and to pick up trophies.

ALL RIDERS PARTICIPATE – Please meet by Steward's Tent

1. Please dismount in the shade once you have left the arena while waiting for your class to finish.
2. Once results are received, horses and riders will be pinned with ribbons and sashes while unmounted. Riders back on your horses!
3. Riders will be escorted to the arena in reverse order in 2 groups:
Group 1: 16th – 7th
Group 2: 6th – Gold Medal.
4. A staff member will direct the riders when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
5. Once around the arena and exit.
6. 16th – 4th return to the barn to take care of your horse.
7. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medalists immediately dismount following your victory lap. You **MUST** have someone present to take your horse following your victory lap. Horses return to the barn.
8. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medalists will be escorted into the arena (unmounted) for award presentations. No horses!
9. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medalists will be escorted to the media tent for your press conference and to pick up trophies.

To keep the conditions safe for everyone, combinations cannot be led around the ring for the victory lap.

DRESSAGE SEAT MEDAL FINAL 13 & UNDER

ALL RIDERS PARTICIPATE – Please meet in Warm-Up

1. Please dismount in the warm-up once you have left the arena while waiting for your class to finish.
2. Once results are received, horses and riders will be pinned with ribbons and sashes while unmounted. Riders back on your horses!
3. Riders will be escorted to the arena in reverse order in 3 groups:
Group 1: 13th – 7th
Group 2: 6th – 4th
Group 3: Bronze, Silver, and Gold Medalists.
4. A staff member will direct the riders when to enter the arena for their victory lap.
5. Once around the arena and exit.
6. 13th – 4th return to the barn to take care of your horse.
7. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medalists immediately dismount following your victory lap. You **MUST** have someone present to take your horse following your victory lap. Horses return to the barn.
8. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medalists will be escorted into the arena (unmounted) for award presentations. No horses!
9. Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medalists will be escorted to the media tent for your press conference and to pick up trophies.
