The November 1st Rolex/USEF Show Jumping Average Ranking List is posted on US Equestrian here.

It is planned that the December 20th Average Ranking List will be used to select the four (4) highest ranked athletes and their horses for the 2020 Olympic Games U.S. Jumping Short List.

All Average Ranking Lists will be updated and posted here on the US Equestrian website as they are published. Two more dates will be published in the 2020 calendar year: December 6th and December 20th.
