



USEF Eventing National Championship League Specifications

Participating Levels: CCI1*, CCI2*, CCI3*, CCI4*

Divisions Per Level: Under 25, Amateurs, Professionals

Participating Members: All U.S. Citizen FEI Eventing athletes competing at the CCI1*, CCI2*, CCI3* and/or CCI4* levels. No opt-in necessary. Scores are automatically accumulated upon completing a U.S. FEI Eventing competition licensed by USEF. Amateur/Professional declarations are based upon declaration at the time of USEF membership.

For the Under 25 divisions at each level, the following FEI ages (as of 1/1) will determine the appropriate category below. If an athlete ages out during the Participation Period (turn 26), they will transition to the Amateur or Professional leaderboards, as applicable.

CCI1*- FEI ages 12-25

CCI2*- FEI ages 14-25

CCI3*- FEI ages 16-15

CCI4*- FEI ages 18-25

Leaderboard:

If an athlete transitions from Amateur to Professional status during the Participation Period, their scores will carry to the Professional leaderboard.

If an athlete transitions from Professional to Amateur status during the Participation Period, they will remain on the Professional Leaderboard until the next Participation Period.

The Leaderboard updates everyday overnight.

Qualifying Competition Criteria: Any U.S. FEI CCI1*, CCI2*, CCI3*, CCI4* competition licensed by USEF

How to Win: The three lowest cumulative scores throughout the participation period. At the CCI2*, CCI3* and CCI4* levels, one of the three scores must be from a Long Format competition. Winners will be awarded for every division as well as an overall League Champion.

Scores: Scores are based on the athlete, not the Athlete/horse combination. Every score counts regardless of if a MER is obtained.

Participation Period: To launch on October 10, 2024, at the Morven International & Fall Horse Trials. The final competition will be held at Morven Park International & Fall Horse Trials on October 9-12, 2025.





Prizes: Ribbons to be distributed through 10th for every division, and the overall League Champion. Trophies and prize money to be determined. Distribution to take place at the final competition.

Final Competition: Attendance is not mandatory, but recognition of achievements will be done at the Morven Fall International and Horse Trials in 2025-2027.
