If you are 18 years of age or older and selected by the USEF to compete on a team or as an individual at a designated team event, as of January 1, 2020, you are required to comply with the updated USEF Background Check Policy. Athletes are strongly encouraged to review the <u>Background Check Policy Requirements</u> for more information.

As of Jan 1, 2019 every USEF adult member (18 years of age or older) with a Competing Membership must complete the <u>U.S. Center for SafeSport Training</u>.
