Re: 2018 FEI WEG Reining Qualification Criteria

Dear U.S. Reining Athletes,

Please review the below FEI Qualification Criteria for Reining at the 2018 FEI World Equestrian Games. Athletes will be required to compete at three (3) CRI3\* events during the qualification period and one (1) CRI3\* competition will have to be in 2018. At two (2) of the CRI3\* events a minimum average score of 70 must be achieved.

**REINING** –Updated 21 June 2017

Qualification Period: Start: 1 January 2017 End: TBC

Minimum qualification criteria (art 303 Reining Rules)

To be eligible to compete either as a member of a team or as an individual at the 2018 FEI World Equestrian Games, an Athlete must be qualified as FEI 3\* Athlete (Art. 304) and achieve a minimum average score of 70 at two out of three different CRI3\* (Championships excluded), all completed with no elimination, disqualification or withdrawal, during the qualification period.

One of the qualifying results as defined above must be achieved no earlier than on the 1st January of the year in which the Championships take place and no later than the end date of the qualification period.

Nations who enter a Team must have organized a CRI of any level or a Reining Championship in their home country during the qualification period. It is not compulsory for the Team members to have participated in this CRI/CH.

An NF that is not able to send a team may send up to two individual Athletes and two Horses who have achieved the minimum qualification criteria as stated above.
