### **USEF Warning Card System**

As of April 1, 2025, the new USEF Warning Card System went into effect.

The Warning Card System rule was amended to encourage and empower Judges,

Stewards, and Technical Delegates to address conduct as it happens and correct

behavior that should not be repeated. As part of the revision of this rule, USEF focused on clarity and flexibility by streamlining the existing Yellow Warning Card process and adding a Recorded Warning process to provide a mechanism for addressing less egregious behavior.

The goal of the revised warning system is to have conduct addressed and documented immediately, be it an infraction that rises to the level of a Yellow Warning Card or is less severe and warrants a Recorded Warning. For more information, please see <a href="here">here</a>.
