- **World Cup Final**, Omaha, NE (USA) - April 4-8
- **Nations Cup Qualifiers**
 - CSIO5* Mexico (San Miguel de Allende) - April 26-30
 - CSIO5* USA (San Juan Capistrano, CA) - May 9-14
 - CSIO5* Canada (Langley, BC) - May 30-June 4
- **Other CSIOs**
 - CSIO4* Wellington (WEF) - February 28-March 6
 - CSIO5* Calgary (Masters) - September 6-10 - *pending invitation*
- **European CSIOs**
 - It is anticipated that we will send teams to some CSIOs this summer. Below are the CSIOs in consideration:
 - CSIO5* La Baule (FRA) June 7-11 - *invitation secured*
 - CSIO5* Aachen (GER) June 27-July 2 - *pending invitation*
 - CSIO5* Falsterbo (SWE) July 13-16 - *tentative*
 - CSIO5* Hickstead (GBR) July 26-30 - *tentative*
 - CSIO5* Dublin (IRL) August 9-13 - *tentative*
- **Nations Cup Final**, Barcelona (ESP) - September 28-October 1 - *pending qualification*
- **Pan American Games**, Santiago (CHI) - October 31-November 5

FEI Wild Card Criteria – Updated

The FEI has updated the criteria for the FEI Wild Card Allocations. Please click [here](#) to review the full document which include eligibility requirements as well as details as to how they are allocated.

A couple of key points:

- US athlete requests for FEI Wild Card invitations must be received by Lizzy Chesson lchesson@usef.org at the latest five weeks prior to an event and must

indicate athlete/horse combination. The FEI will not accept requests directly from an athlete.

- Athletes are not eligible for FEI Wild Cards at home events. For example, a US athlete is not eligible for the FEI Wild Card at CSI5* Wellington.
