



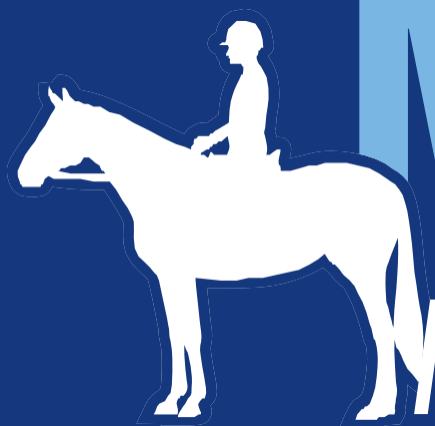
# DOCUMENTS TO BE POSTED AT A USEF LITE COMPETITION

## REQUIRED

1. On-call veterinarian information / measurement times (GR1211.5)
2. Directions to the competition grounds (GR1216.8)
3. Name, address, and telephone number of the closest veterinary emergency and surgical facility (GR1216.9)
4. USEF Safe Sport Sign 'You Are Not Alone' in English and Spanish (see attached)
5. USEF MAAPP Poster and a copy of the sample letter (see attached)
6. [Isolation Plan](#) to be printed and posted (GR874)

## RECOMMENDED

1. Copy of the Accident Preparedness Plan – to include:
  - emergency call/radio priority protocol
  - list of emergency telephone numbers (manager, medical personnel, vet, ambulance)
  - directions to the competition that can be relayed to offsite responders
  - name and contact information of the Safety Coordinator
2. Directions to nearest hospital for human and equine
3. Copy of the isolation protocol
4. [Fever Flyer](#)
5. Map of competition grounds
6. Farrier contact information – on grounds or on-call
7. Directional signage around the facility
8. If there are common areas with vehicles and horse/humans - signage to separate
9. Parking signage

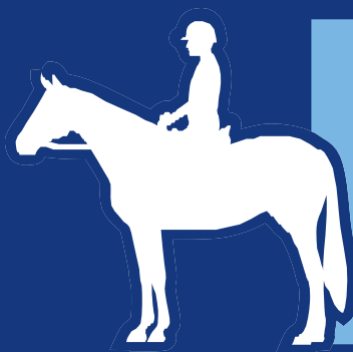
