Re: 2018 FEI World Equestrian Games for Driving Horses four-in-hand

Please be advised that the proposed qualifying period for the 2018 FEI World Equestrian Games for Driving Horses four-in-hand ("the Event") began **September 15, 2017** and will end on the FEI Nominated Entry date (TBD by the FEI) for the Event. Athlete/Horse combinations who wish to apply for the FEI Nominated Entry must complete at least three (3) **Selection Trials** - with at least two (2) of those being within the same calendar year of the Event. Applicants must also meet all USEF criteria stated in the Selection Procedures and in the USEF Rulebook, as well as meet the FEI qualifying criteria for the Event. Athletes intending to compete at any European CAIs shall notify the USEF Director of Driving of their activities in writing no later than three (3) weeks prior to the start of the competition(s) in question. Additionally, please be reminded that if an athlete plans to compete in any European CAI competitions, he/she must adhere to the USEF Criteria to compete in Foreign Competitions.

To Apply:

Applications will be accepted online, via the "My USEF" portal, with a \$70 application fee until the <u>deadline</u> of February 1, 2018. After the deadline, applications will still be accepted with a late-application fee of \$300 until 2 weeks before the FEI Nominated Entries (TBD). Please refer to the approved 2018 Selection Procedures for complete details and required paperwork. Applicants should expect to be included in ranking lists published by the 2018 USEF Selection Committee. Note: Rankings will NOT guarantee selection on the team.

<u>Mandatory Outing</u>: The decision whether to have a Mandatory Outing will be announced by **May 1, 2018**. If held, all Athletes on the FEI Nominated Entry will be expected to attend a Mandatory Outing, which is a training session held sometime between the FEI Nominated Entry date and before the Event. The dates and location, anticipated to be in close proximity to the Event, will be announced at least 30 days before the Event.
