

2026 U.S. Eventing Team Opportunities Application and Selection Timelines

In order to be considered for a U.S. Eventing Team, an Athlete must submit an application through their <u>Athlete</u> <u>Dashboard</u> on the USEF website. Application dates for 2026 Team opportunities are below.

U.S. FEI Registered Eventing Athletes will be notified via the emailed USEF FEI newsletters when applications open, and application directions are available on the <u>USEF website</u>. Deadlines are enforced without exception.

Targeted U.S. Eventing Team Opportunities:

European Development Tour:

Selection for the Tour is governed by the <u>2026 Eventing European Development Tour Selection Procedures</u>. Athletes must be current or past participants in the <u>USEF Eventing Development 25 or Development Programs</u>. Past participants in the USEF Eventing Development 25 or Development Programs are eligible for the Tour, provided they have participated in either Program within the 3 years preceding application (2025, 2024 or 2023).

The Tour will consist of up to four (4) Athletes and will target the following FEI Nations Cup:

Definition of Team Staff Roles:

<u>Chef d'Equipe</u> - the Chef d'Equipe is appointed by the USEF to oversee the management of the Athletes and Horses concerning Team and Individual performance.

<u>Team Leader</u> – the Team Leader is a member of the USEF Eventing Staff that supports the Chef d'Equipe and oversees the management of the Team logistics, including transportation, accommodations, and credentials.

<u>Team Veterinarian</u> – The Team Veterinarian is responsible for the observance of the FEI Veterinary Regulations and the execution of each Horse's care protocols. Personal veterinarians may attend the Event but must be under the supervision of the Team Veterinarian.
