U.S. EQUESTRIAN COMBINED DRIVING NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CRITERIA

Approved by the Driving Sport Committee on December 5, 2018 to be effective in 2019.

Updated with approval by the Driving Sport Committee on March 27, 2019 to be effective immediately.

This criteria is subject to review each year by the Driving Sport Committee. Athlete/horse combinations that do not meet the required criteria may still enter a class running the USEF National Championships, but they will **not** participate in the National Championship placings.

Athlete/horse combinations are defined as an athlete with the same horse(s)/ponies; for multiples (pairs and four-in-hands) a combination is considered the same until 50% or more of the horse(s)/ponies are changed.

This criteria applies to the following divisions/classes at the designated host venues, as follows:

Advanced Four-in-hand Horse and Advanced Pair Horse classes at Live Oak International CAI 2* (Ocala, FL | March 6-10, 2019)

All Advanced Pony classes at Southern Pines CAI 2* (Raeford, NC | April 11-14, 2019)

All Intermediate and Preliminary classes at Garden State CDE (Allentown, NJ | October 11-13, 2019)

Advanced Single Horses at Katydid CAI 2* (Windsor, SC | October 31 – November 3, 2019)

Criteria required for participation

A. Membership and Horse Recording Requirements:

- i. Athletes must be U.S. Citizens.
- ii. Athletes must be active competing members in good standing with USEF during the event.
- iii. Athletes must be of eligible age as defined in Subchapter DC-4 of the USEF Combined Driving rules.
- iv. Horses/Ponies must have an annual or life recording with USEF during the event.
- v. Horses/Ponies must be of eligible age as defined in Subchapter DC-6 of the USEF Combined Driving rules.

B. Qualifying Requirements:

- i. Athletes / horse combinations must have completed at least one event within 24 18 months (without elimination, retirement or disqualification) at the same division level as the Championship.
- ii. Athlete / horse combinations may only participate in one National Championship division level within the same year.
- iii. All Athletes and Horses/Ponies are subject to USEF rules and policies as published on usef.org.

C. Results Criteria:

i. Athlete / horse combinations must achieve the following applicable scores at the event to win the respective classes for the National Championship:

a. Singles and Pairs: total overall score of 185 or less

b. Four in-hands: total overall score of 200 or less
