2022 U.S. EQUESTRIAN COMBINED DRIVING NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CRITERIA

Approved by the Driving Sport Committee on June 14, 2021.

This criteria is subject to review each year by the Driving Sport Committee. Athletes and horses/ponies that do **not** meet the required criteria **may still enter a class** also running the USEF National Championships, but they will not be included in the National Championship placings (Refer to DC 928.2.2.2 for participation).

This criteria applies to the following National Championship divisions/classes at the designated host venues, as follows:

USEF Advanced Pony (single, pair, four-in-hand) Combined Driving National Championships and the **USEF Advanced Pair horse Combined Driving National Championship** at Live Oak International from March 2-6 in Ocala, Florida.

USEF Advanced Single horse Combined Driving National Championship at the Katydid CDE from April 20-24 in Mill Spring, North Carolina.

USEF Advanced Four-in-hand horse Combined Driving National Championship at the Kentucky Classic CDE at Hermitage from June 2-5 in Goshen, Kentucky.

USEF Intermediate Combined Driving National Championships (All Classes) at the Tryon CDE from September 21-25 in Mill Spring, North Carolina.

USEF Preliminary Combined Driving National Championships (All Classes) at the Garden State CDE from October 6-9 in Allentown, New Jersey.

Criteria required for participation

A. Membership and Horse Recording Requirements:

- i. Athletes must be U.S. Citizens.
- ii. Athletes must be active competing members in good standing with USEF during the event.
- iii. Athletes must be of eligible age as defined in Subchapter DC-4 of the USEF Combined Driving rules.
- iv. Horses/Ponies must have a current annual or life recording with USEF during the event.
- v. Horses/Ponies must be of eligible age as defined in Subchapter DC-6 of the USEF Combined Driving rules.

B. Qualifying Requirements:

- i. Athletes must have completed **at least two events** (without elimination, retirement or disqualification) at the same **division level** as the Championship prior to the start of the competition.
- ii. Athletes may participate in different National Championships within the same year, but horses/ponies are **not** permitted to compete in multiple National Championships within the same calendar year.
