#### **European CSIOs**

It is anticipated that four (4) European CSIOs prior to June 23, 2020 will be utilized for Tokyo Observation Events for the Short List. However, additional CSIOs are being considered outside the Olympic Selection Procedures – look for more information this winter.

Beginning in the Fall of 2020, there will be one League (no Sub-Leagues) comprised of eight (8) qualifying events. An athlete's best four (4) results will count for qualification. The number of U.S. athletes to qualify will remain unchanged: seven (7) East Coast athletes and three (3) West Coast athletes.

December 20, 2019 Rolex/USEF "Average Ranking List" Date for Phase I Short List Selection

**Phase I** - The 4 highest ranked athletes on the December 20<sup>th</sup> Rolex/USEF Average Ranking List will be named to the Short List

December 23, 2019 USEF Application Deadline - Phase I

January 15, 2020 FEI Registration Deadline – Horses to be U.S. Owned

All horses selected for the Olympic Games must be registered with the

FEI as property of owners of U.S. nationality

February 10, 2020 USEF Application Deadline - Phase II Early

February 20, 2020 USEF Application Deadline - Phase II Final

February 25, 2020 USOPC Registration Deadline

All individuals who have the potential to travel to Tokyo as an accredited

individual **must complete USOPC Registration** by this date – this

includes athletes, grooms, horse owners, etc.

April 3, 2020 Phase II Short List Selection

"Horse Ranking List" - The 3 highest ranked athletes on the April 3rd

Rolex/USEF "Horse Ranking List", not already named in Phase 1 Selection

April 20, 2020 By no later than April 20, the Short List of 10 athletes and their horses will

be finalized, including:

**World Cup Final** – The highest placed U.S. athlete in the top 10 of the

Final Overall Standings at the 2020 World Cup Final in Las Vegas  $\,$ 

(USA), not already named in Phase I Selection

**Discretionary Selection** – 2 athletes recommended by the Chef

d'Equipe in consultation with the Selectors

May – June, 2020 Short List to compete at Designated Observation Events

June 1, 2020 FEI Nominated Entries & Certificates of Capability

Up to 9 athletes and 12 horses

June 23, 2020 Selection Finalized & USOPC Entries Submitted

Late July, 2020 Pre-Export Quarantine – 7 Days

August 4-8, 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games - Jumping
